DEPUTY GENERAL MANAGER - CABONNE INFRASTRUCTURE'S REPORT

The following report provides an update on major projects up to the end of May 2024.

Four Mile Creek Road

Work has been completed and the road has been re-opened.

Tree vegetation work

- Council has hired an arborist and a 12 inch tree chipper to work with council crews cleaning up fallen timber and regrowth by hand along (either partial sections or the whole road) the road shoulders on the following roads:
 - Mount Canobolas Road
 - Pinnacle Road
 - Belgravia Road
 - Strathnook Lane (and all roads within Clifton Grove)
 - Lower Lewis Ponds Road
 - Borenore Road
 - Bradleys Road
 - Offner Road
 - Griffin Lane
 - Convent Lane.

RERRF drainage work

- Bevan Road – working with contractors – cleaning table drains, and mitre drains has been completed.
- Bevan Road – working with contractors – cleaning of selected blocked culverts will start on 3 June 2024 and should take 2 days to complete.
- Belgravia Road – working with contractors – cleaning of table drains, and mitre drains between Tantallon Road and Kangaroo Road. This is due to be completed by 16 June 2024.
- Belgravia Road – working with contractors – cleaning of selected blocked culverts. This will start once contractors have completed work on Bevan Road and should be completed within a week.

- Cargo Road – working with contractors – continuing to clean out table drains from Lidster Rural Fire Service shed to Cargo. This is due to be completed by the end of June 2024
- Cargo Road – working with contractors – cleaning of selected blocked culverts will start after Belgravia Road and should take 1 week to complete.
- Spring Hill Road and Four Mile Creek Road drainage work is due to start early June and will take approx. 4 weeks to complete.

Amaroo Road

Work has been completed.

Contractor has commenced work on site. The project is due for completion in mid-2024.

Pinecliffe Road causeway

The road remains closed due to damage caused by the ARGN 1034 natural disaster event. Tender documentation is being prepared and council is expecting to release the tender documents by mid-June 2024.

Washpen Creek bridge

Project is due for completion in early July 2024.

Peak Hill Road Upgrade – Roads of Significant Importance (ROSI)

The tender has been released and closes on 5 June 2024. Land acquisition work will commence when a contractor is engaged. Additional geo-tech test pits are required, and the geo-tech investigation work has started. This has resulted in an increase in costs. Tender is expected to be released after June 2024.

Footpaths in Cabonne

Works commenced on the 27 May 2024 to construct a 2.5m wide shared pathway along Belmore Street (Wall Street to Church Street), the pathway extends into Cargo Village Green to allow connectivity to existing infrastructure.

Works are expected to be completed by 21 June 2024 and are being undertaken by Keech Construction Pty Ltd.

Cargo is the final shared pathway to be installed under the Get NSW Active and Local Roads & Community Infrastructure Program 2024.

Molong Gasworks Lane

Work includes:

- Barrier kerb around the perimeter of the carpark has been completed.
- 76m of footpath has been constructed.
- Gasworks Lane has been stabilised.
- Gasworks Lane & carpark is scheduled to be sealed Wednesday 29 May 2024.
- Hot mixing of the Molong caravan park and part of the entrance into Gasworks Lane (between the caravan park and mechanics) has been completed.
- Balance of the footpaths will be installed by the end of the financial year.
- Currently working with the NRMA to develop plans and install EV charging stations.
