Increased Road Works A Priority In 2024-25

The community may notice works being undertaken by road crews completing drainage, vegetation and culvert cleanouts on roads across the LGA. These works are part of flood recovery funding received to make our roads more resilient to future flood events.

There will be significant disruptions to most of the road network across Cabonne as Council works to deliver more than \$40m+ of road repairs, culvert upgrades, drainage works, and clearing in the next 12-18 months.

All road users are asked to be prepared for delays and plan trips early.

- Home raising
- Home retrofits
- Home assessments

These sessions are individual sessions for home-owners with a NSW Reconstruction consultant.

New Projects Delivered

Council is pleased to report that four major projects have been completed in past month:

▶ Molong Town Centre Activation Plan

- **Funding:** Co-funded by the Federal Government's Building Better Regions Fund and the NSW Government's Resources for Regions Fund.
- **Cost:** \$2.18 million.
- **Goals:** Enhance Molong as a regional destination, improve walkability, stimulate private investment, and boost local business and tourism.

▶ Nyrang Creek Bridge Replacement

- **Funding:** NSW Government
- **Cost:** \$1.3 million.
- **Reason:** Replacement due to November 2022 flooding.
- **Features:** Enhanced design for flood mitigation (1 in 20-year flood).

▶ Manildra Female Changeroom Reconstruction at Jack Huxley Oval

- **Funding:** NSW and Federal Governments
- **Cost:** \$550k
- **Goal:** Increase female participation in sports with new facilities.
- **Features:** Home and away team changerooms, benched seating, toilets, and showers.

▶ Tom Clyburn Grandstand Reconstruction at Canowindra Sports Oval

- **Funding:** NSW Government
- **Cost:** \$1,8m
- **Features:** Spectator seating for 210 people, change rooms with showers and toilets, female and male toilets, unisex/disabled/baby changeroom, referee's room with shower and toilet, new canteen/bar.
