Project Delivery Update 2024-25

Council is currently working through its program of works for the 24/25 financial year, and will be working to deliver a number of major projects over the next 12 months including:

- Approximately \$60m of road repair works following the 22 floods. These works are on top of the approximately \$15m regular roads program Council will deliver.
- Completion of the Canowindra Town Centre Activation Plan.
- Upgrades to all seven Cabonne swimming pools (Cumnock, Cudal, Canowindra, Molong, Manildra, Eugowra, and Yeoval) – primarily centred around plant room and pump upgrades.
- New multi-purpose tennis courts in Cargo.
- Additional works at the Yeoval Recreation Grounds, including a new tennis shed.
- New toilets and amenities at Montana Park in Manildra
- Completion of the Eugowra Evacuation Centre
- New town and village signage across all of the LGA.
- Completion of the upgrade to Washpen Bridge at Obley.
- Upgrade to the play equipment at Pillons Park in Molong.
- Commencement of the Home and Community Care Building Refurbishment in Canowindra.

Council is also awaiting news of funding applied for 11 projects through the Community Assets Program, which is part of the Central West Flood Resilience and Recovery Fund.

Road Works Update: 2 Years Post-Floods - Impact on Travel Starting Late August

Starting in late August, significant roadworks will commence as part of our ongoing recovery efforts two years post-floods. These essential works will improve infrastructure but may impact your travel plans. Council appreciates your patience and cooperation as we work to enhance our roads for everyone's safety and convenience. Stay tuned for more updates.
