KEEP WATCH AT PUBLIC POOLS

All Cabonne Council swimming pools enforce the Keep Watch at Public Pools Guidelines. All children aged 14 years and under must be accompanied and directly supervised by a responsible adult 16 years or older, this age can be reduced to 11 years of age on the successful completion of the youth swim test and parental permission.

0-5 years old and weak or non-swimmers: parents/guardians must give all their attention, stay close to them (within arms- reach) and watch them continuously.

6-10-year-old: be close, be prepared to enter the water, and maintain constant visual contact.

11-14-year-old: maintain visual contact.
